Arrival for the first day of each weekend is 7:30 a.m. Departure on the last day of each weekend is 5 p.m. To graduate, attendance at all portions of the training is mandatory. The first weekend is held primarily in a classroom with overnight stay in campsites. The second weekend is an outdoor camping experience. A full, complete, and official adult leader uniform will be worn during the course. You must complete all basic training courses for your current primary registered Scouting position before the first day of this course. A current [BSA Annual Health and Medical Record](#), parts A, B, and C is also required.

COURSE FEE

West Central Florida Council Refund Policy: All requests for activity refunds need to be in writing and received in the council service center at least ten (10) business days before the activity. A twenty percent (20%) service charge will be assessed, unless the registration fees are being transferred to another activity in the same calendar year.
